## CONSULTATION MEETING WITH PHILIPPINE FDA

Last October 07, 2019, PCRP met with Deputy Director General Maria Lourdes C. Santiago for a consultative meeting and discussed the following topics:

- Draft Administrative Order on the Regulation of Clinical Trials;
- Timelines for regulatory submission in relation to Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018;
- Timelines and schedule of FDA Regulatory Reviewers:
- Feedback on the FDA Circular 2012-007-A:
   A Reduction of Turn-Around-Time for the Regulatory Review of Clinical Trials and Revised Procedure for the Application of Import Permit for Investigational Medicinal Products

PCRP suggested minor changes in the draft AO on Regulation of Clinical Trials. It was also suggested that when using the Import License to the Bureau of Customs attach the BOC Circular 177-2019 (copy attached).
